Sabrina has been dedicated to physical wellness and activity for most of her life. Enrolled in her first dance class at the young age of 3 it wasn't long before she fell in love with the art. Over the years she pursued her passion by furthering her dance education through lessons as well as workshops and later began to teach. For the past 24 years Sabrina has taught children of all ages (2- Adulthood) in recreational as well as competitive levels. For over 18 years she has proven to be a successful choreographer of Jazz, Tap & Hip Hop...including being the recipient of 'Award Winning Choreographer' at well-known Dance Competitions.

Sabrina has attended many auditions including (making the top 25 out of 400) for the Toronto Raptors as well as auditioning for and becoming a member of the 2001 & 2002 Toronto Argonaut's Dance Team, performing at all home games and two GREY CUPS.

Along with many talented instructors, we are **FUSION Studio of Performing Arts**. Our passion for the arts, along with our desire to perform, teach and inspire is what has brought us here today!

ATTIRE

During class, we ask that the students wear proper dance attire for Jazz/Tap & Tech classes; body suits, leotards, active wear, jazz pants, and tights are some examples of appropriate dancewear. **BAGGY SWEATS** and **STREET CLOTHES /JEANS ARE NOT ACCEPTED**. It is important for us to view proper form and body placement. (Sweats are only permitted during the warm up segment of the class) We also ask that hair be worn accordingly (ie: tied back, worn off the face, etc...)

** Hip Hop classes; appropriate wear & accessories (ie. Baggy sweats/bandanas etc) are permitted and dance sneakers or clean/indoor runners **must** be worn for shoes – no jazz shoes please!

STUDIO

Please note the following:

- The side door (bottom of stairs-DOWN) will be our main entrance for FUSiON.
- Parking is available in the lot as well as on Currie St. & Facer St. (on busy nights & for older students). We recommend dropping off students indoors and then returning for pick up.
- For the nicer weather, we have an **outdoor** area for parents to hang out.
- In the lower level there is a 'reception area' for parents & siblings etc. to wait. There is a separate 'locker room' for students to get ready for class, leave their coats/jackets and outdoor shoes as well as store other belongings. **(Dance bags & shoes brought into the studio)** Keeping these 2 rooms separate will help keep areas less congested!
- Our main bathroom is located off of Reception area
- Our upper level has 4 studios!!
